## ADULT PROGRAMS

### VOCATIONAL EVALUATION

Provides an individual with the opportunity to engage in career exploration by trying out a variety of simulated jobs.

### WORK ADJUSTMENT TRAINING

Short term, paid work experiences designed to help individuals develop workforce skills, including attendance, punctuality, productivity, and more.

### EXTENDED EMPLOYMENT

Job coaching services are designed to assist an individual in acclimating to the work culture and honing job-specific skills, then gradually fade as the new employee becomes more independent.

### JOB PLACEMENT

After our clients have been placed in jobs, they will receive lifelong services here at Life'sWork, including regular on-site visits, counseling, and follow along to promote job retention and long term career advancement.

## YOUTH PROGRAMS

### PROJECT CHOICE

A self-sufficiency program for juvenile offenders and at-risk youth who may or may not have a disability.

### PROJECT MATCH

Helps young adults with significant disabilities to transition from the classroom to the working world.

### YOUTH WORK READINESS PROGRAM

This program is designed to assist both in school and out of school youths to successfully transition into the workforce.

### PRE-EMPLOYMENT TRAINING SERVICES

Assists Allegheny County high school students with a disability with opportunities to prepare for employment after graduation.
